Arrival and Registration

Upon arrival, please come to the registration table to pick up your conference package and name tag.

The registration table is located at the **Longueuil Campus of the University of Sherbrooke**, 150 place Charles-Le-Moyne, Longueuil, J4K 0A8. It is open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday 6 July through Thursday 9 July.

Walk from Sandman Hotel (5 minutes):

- Cross rue De Serigny to Place Charles-Le-Moyne
- Past the Metro Station (Longueuil) on the right hand side is 150 Place Charles Le Moyne

Walk from Hotel Le Dauphin (10 minutes):

- Make a left on Charles Le Moyne. Take the foot path that goes under the highway on the west (left) side of Charles-Le-Moyne
- On the other side of the highway, you should see the Université de Sherbrooke campus
- 150 place Charles Le Moyne is the first building on the left hand side

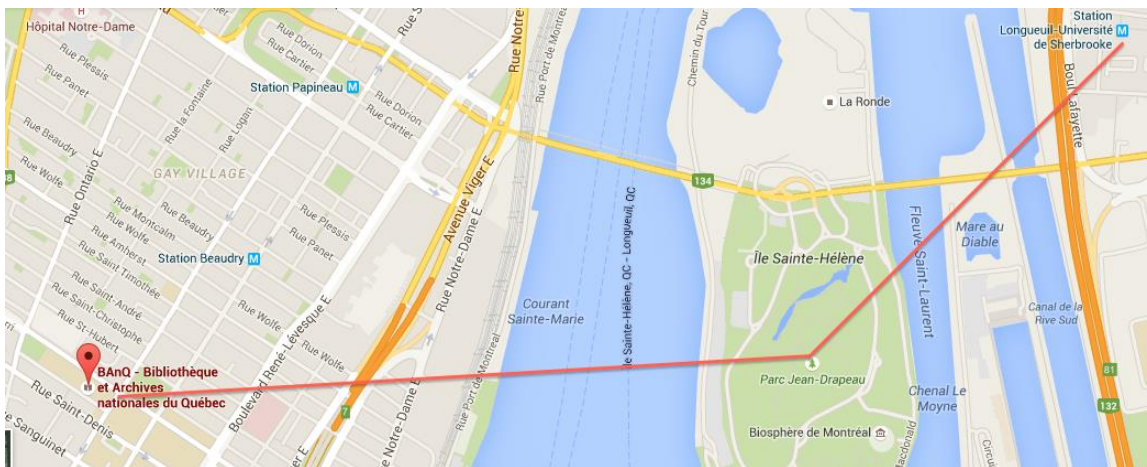


Tuesday 7 July: BAnQ Grande Bibliothèque

The conference opens at 1:30 pm on Tuesday 7 July at the **Grande Bibliothèque** (GB) of Bibliothèque et Archives nationales du Québec (BAnQ), 475 boulevard de Maisonneuve est, Montreal, H2L 5C4.

Take the Metro (Subway) from Longueuil–Université de Sherbrooke Station:

- The metro costs \$3.25 for a single fare. The best option would be to buy a 3-day pass (\$18) and then buy a separate fare on the 4th day. The metro leaves Longueuil station every 4–5 minutes during rush hour (7 to 9 am & 4 to 6 pm) and otherwise every 5–10 minutes.
- Give yourself half an hour to make the trip.
- The Longueuil metro station is a terminus so there is no risk of getting on the wrong line.
- Get off at Berri-UQAM station. Follow signs for exit/sortie. Once at turnstiles, you will see a sign for “Grande Bibliothèque”. Take the escalator up to the GB.



Thursday 9 July: Banquet

The conference banquet will take place from 7 to 10 pm on Thursday 9 July at the **Pavillon de la Jamaïque, Parc Jean-Drapeau**, on Notre Dame Island in the Saint Lawrence River.

Take the Metro (Subway) from Longueuil–Université de Sherbrooke Station:

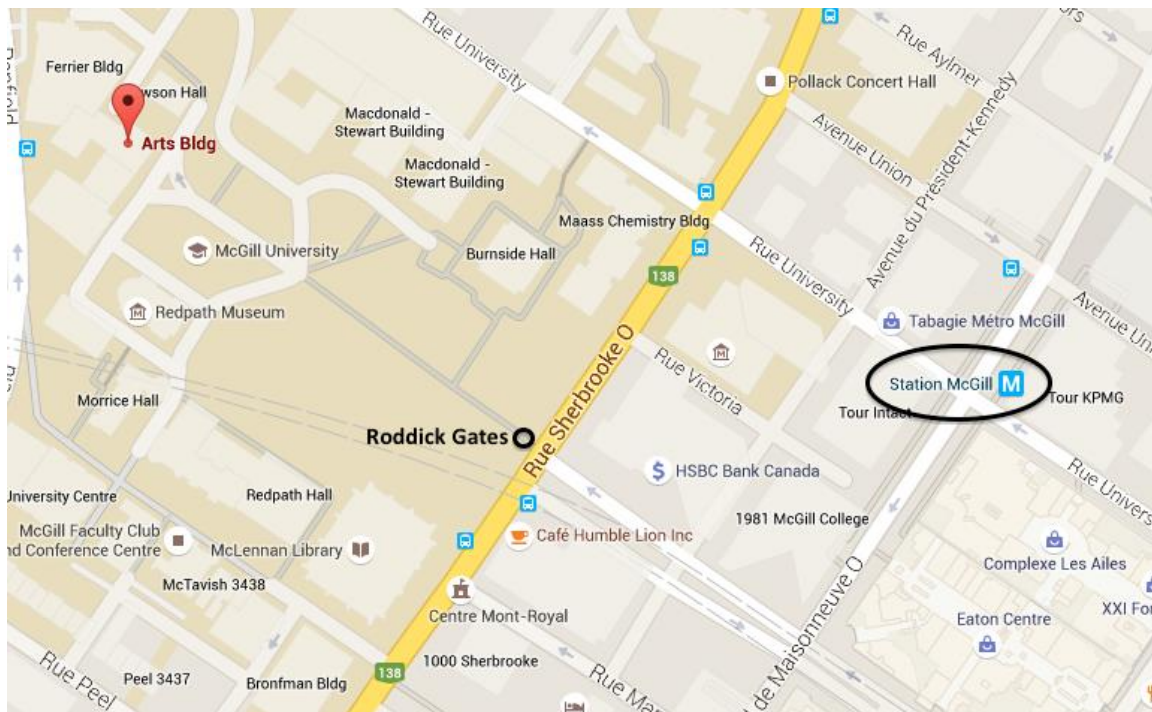
- Give yourself half an hour to make the trip.
- Get off at Jean-Drapeau station. Follow signs for bus 777. The bus departing at 6:21, 6:36, or 6:51 pm will get you there on time.
- Ride bus 777 to the Casino; this is the only stop (about 5–7 minutes).
- At the Casino, you will see a walkway on the right of the main entrance. Follow that pathway until it ends. You will see a bridge on your left, follow the bridge across the stream until you see the white Pavillon de la Jamaïque.

Friday 10 July: McGill University

The last day of the conference will take place in the **Arts Building at McGill University**, 853 rue Sherbrooke Ouest, Montreal, H3A 0G5, beginning at 8:30 am.

Take the Metro (Subway) from Longueuil–Université de Sherbrooke Station:

- Give yourself forty-five minutes to make the trip.
- From Berri-UQAM station, take the Green line metro (direction: Angrignon).
- Get off at McGill station. Exit onto boulevard Robert-Bourassa (formerly University street.)
- Walk north (uphill) on Robert-Bourassa/University to Sherbrooke street. Turn left and walk west on Sherbrooke. You will arrive at the main gates of McGill University (the Roddick Gates).
- A pedestrian-road runs straight from the gates through the campus to the Arts Building (including Moyse Hall), which has the school flag flying above it.

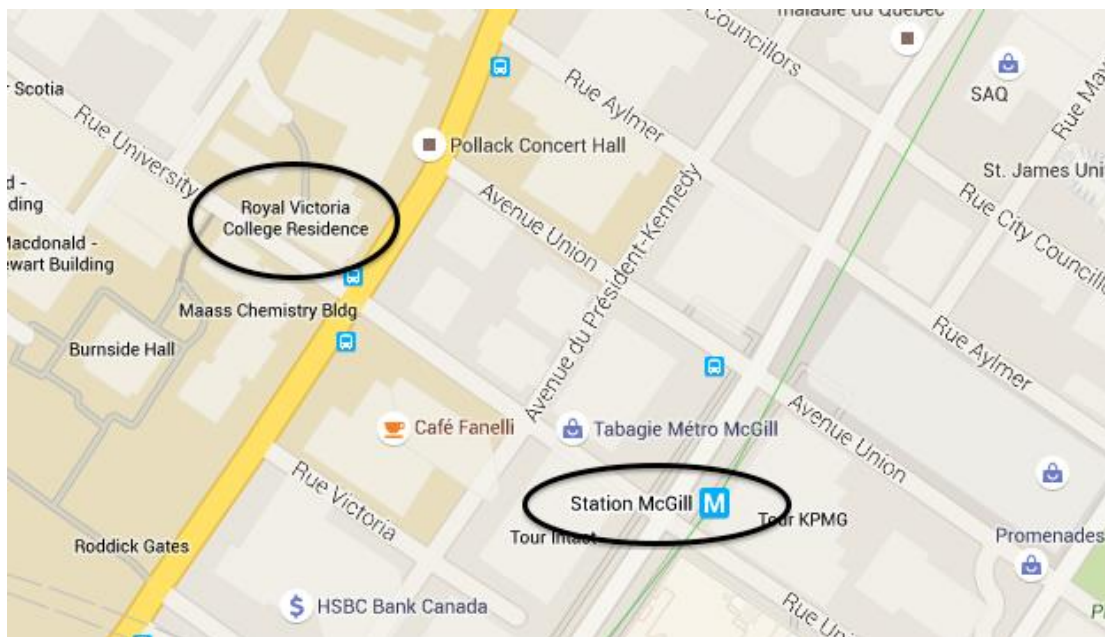
Arrival and Registration

Upon arrival, please come to the registration table to pick up your conference package and name tag.

The registration table is located at the **Longueuil Campus of the University of Sherbrooke**, 150 place Charles-Le-Moyne, Longueuil, J4K 0A8. It is open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday 6 July through Thursday 9 July.

Take the Metro (Subway) from McGill Station:

- Give yourself forty-five minutes to make the trip.
- Walk south (downhill) on boulevard Robert-Bourassa (formerly University street) to boulevard de Maisonneuve and enter the McGill metro station.
- The metro costs \$3.25 for a single fare. The best option would be to buy a 3-day pass (\$18).
- Take the metro (direction: Honoré Beaugrand) to Berri-UQAM station.
- Transfer at Berri-UQAM station to the yellow line (direction: Longueuil–Université-de-Sherbrooke).
- Get off at Longueuil–Université-de-Sherbrooke station. Walk up the stairs to the concourse with the shops. Directly behind you as you come up the stairs is a green sign indicating the hallway into the Université de Sherbrooke building. Walk into the Université de Sherbrooke building and up the broad staircase to the second floor.

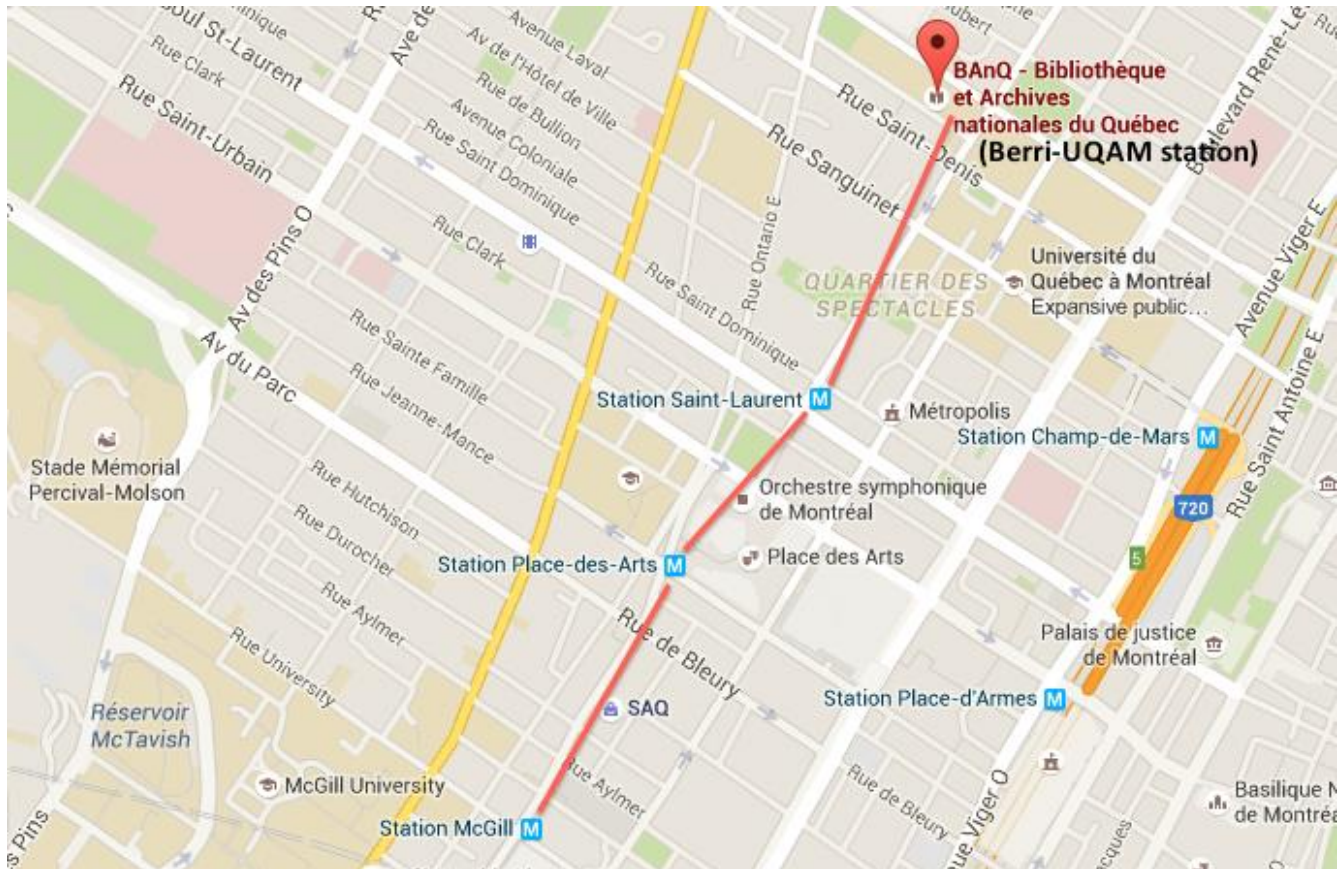


Tuesday 7 July: BAnQ Grande Bibliothèque

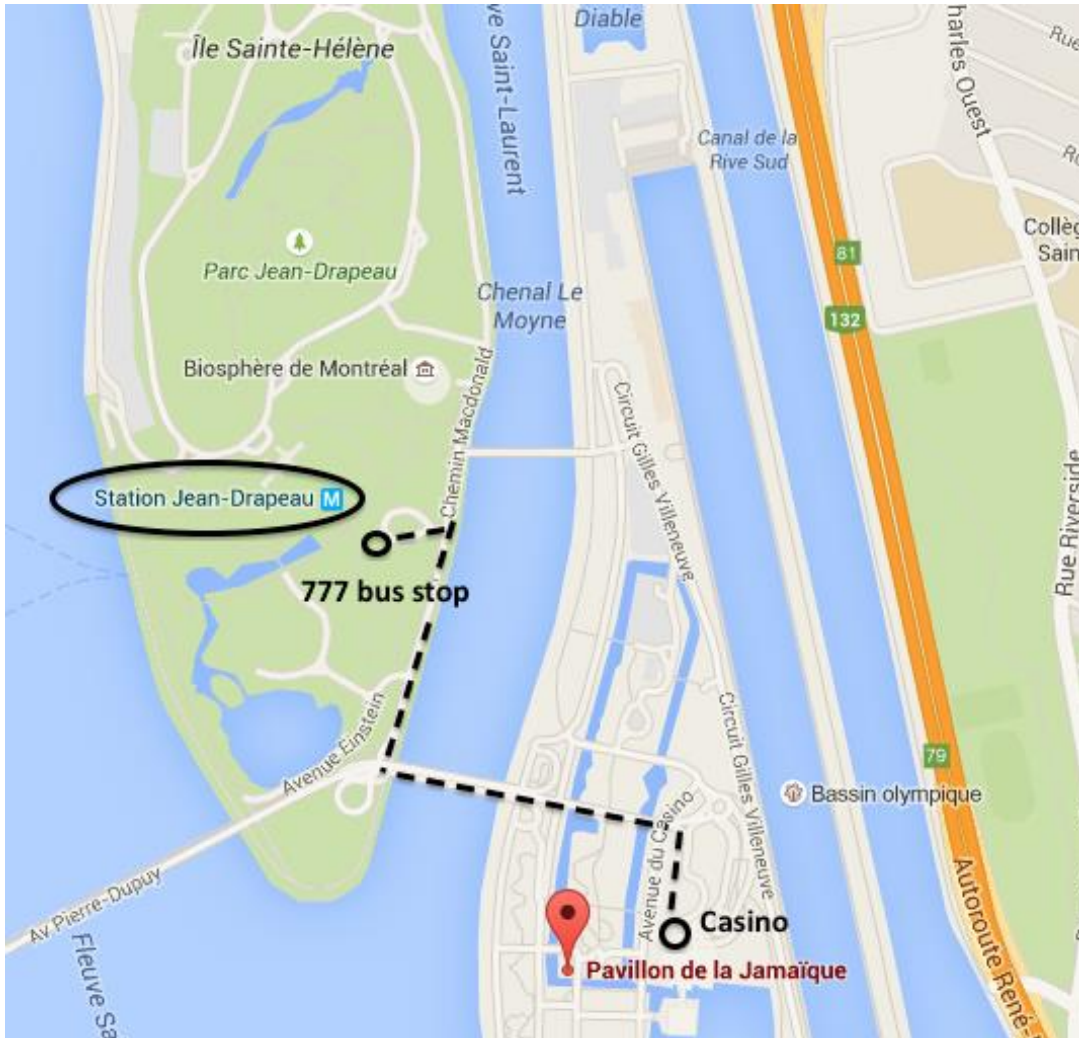
Thursday 9 July: Banquet
